The Newark Public Library has proposed an 8-cent tax increase per \$1,000 in assessed property value. A vote will be held on Tuesday, May 16 from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM at the Newark High School Gym. If passed, the cost to the average household will increase by \$7.06 per year.

- Newark Central School District residents 18 years of age or older may vote.
- You do not have to be registered to vote on or before May 16 to vote on the budget. You can fill out a form at the booth the day of the vote.
- You can vote on the budget on Tuesday, May 16, from 9 A.M. to 8 P.M. at the Newark High School at 625 Peirson Ave.
- Applications for absentee ballots shall be obtainable from 9 A.M. to 4 P.M. Monday through Friday at the Newark Central School District Offices on 100 Miller Street, Newark, NY starting May 2, 2017. The School District office must receive completed applications at least seven (7) days before the vote and election. A
