Important information about the vote:

- Newark Central School District 18 years of age or older may vote.
- You do not have to be registered to vote on or before May 18. You can fill out a form at the voting booth the day of the vote.
- You can vote on the library’s funding proposition on Tuesday, May 18, from 9AM to 8PM at the Newark High School, 625 Peirson Avenue.
- Applications for absentee ballots can be picked up from 9AM to 4PM Monday through Friday at the Newark Central School District Office, 100 East Miller Street. The school district office must receive completed applications at least seven (7) days before the vote and election.
- The library will hold a budget hearing on Thursday, May 6 from 6-6:30PM to allow voters to learn more about the library’s budget and ask questions.
