



3D PRINTER POLICY

The Newark Public Library's 3D printers are used exclusively for library-led programs and instructional activities.

The library does not offer on-demand or individual 3D printing services for the public at this time.

All use of the library's 3D printers is supervised by library staff and occurs as part of scheduled programs designed and led by the library.

3D printers may be used only for lawful purposes. The library will not produce materials or objects that:

- Are prohibited by local, state, or federal law.
- Violate the library's Code of Conduct.
- Are unsafe, harmful, dangerous, or pose a risk to staff or participants.
- Infringe on copyright, patent, or trademark protections.

The library reserves the right to determine appropriate use of the equipment within programs and to decline any proposed activity or design.

The library is not responsible for the functionality, durability, or quality of objects produced during programs.

This policy reflects current operational use of the equipment and may be revised if public access or service models change in the future.
